

*In those days there was no king in Israel. Everyone did what was right in his own eyes.*

Judges 21:25

*<sup>6</sup> When Joshua dismissed the people, the people of Israel went each to his inheritance to take possession of the land. <sup>7</sup> And the people served the Lord all the days of Joshua ...*

*<sup>10</sup> ... And there arose another generation after them who did not know the Lord or the work that He had done for Israel.*

*<sup>11</sup> And the people of Israel did what was evil in the sight of the Lord and served the Baals. <sup>12</sup> And they abandoned the Lord, the God of their fathers, who had brought them out of the land of Egypt. They went after other gods ...*

*<sup>14</sup> So the anger of the Lord was hot against Israel, and He gave them over to plunderers, who plundered them. And He sold them into the hand of their surrounding enemies ...*

*<sup>16</sup> Then the Lord raised up judges, who saved them out of the hand of those who plundered them. <sup>17</sup> Yet they did not listen to their judges, for they whored after other gods and bowed down to them.*

*<sup>18</sup> Whenever the Lord raised up judges for them, the Lord was with the judge, and He delivered them from the hand of their enemies all the days of the judge; for the Lord was moved to pity by their groaning because of those who afflicted and oppressed them.*

*<sup>19</sup> But whenever the judge died, they turned back and were more corrupt than their fathers, going after other gods, serving them and bowing down to them. They did not drop any of their practices or their stubborn ways.*
